The Plover Wastewater Utility will be dye testing sanitary and storm sewers along the Post Road construction project from September 6 through 9. The dye will be red or yellow and is highly visible. The dye is expected to be visible in areas where storm sewers discharge to receiving waters, such as Springville Pond.

The dye product is certified safe for plant, animal, and aquatic life. The dye is highly visible and persistent. It may take up to two weeks for it to dissipate naturally, depending on water and weather conditions. .
