

Early voting (in-person absentee) will begin Monday, October 3, 2016 and will end Friday, November 4, 2016.

Early voting will take place Monday through Friday 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with the exception of Thursday, November 3 and Friday November 4 with hours until 5:00 p.m.

In order to vote, electors will be required to show photo ID. e.g. Wisconsin driver's license/ID, Passport, Military ID, Veterans ID just to name a few. A complete list of acceptable forms of photo ID can be found on the state's website at www.gab.wi.gov

You can check if you are registered to vote by going to "Voter Search" on the State of Wisconsin's link at <https://myvote.wi.gov/>. If you are not registered to vote in the Village of Plover, you can click on "Register to Vote" under "Information About Voting" and follow the instructions. You will also be able to register to vote at the same time you early vote in the Clerk's office.

Please be aware of the following when registering to vote:

You must provide your Wisconsin driver's license or Wisconsin ID number if you have been issued one.

When registering, if your driver's license or Wisconsin ID does not reflect your current address, you must bring along another form of proof of residency.

Proof of residence is required of all registrants. You can find a list of acceptable forms of proof of residence on the Village of Plover's website at <http://www.ploverwi.gov/clerkdept.htm>.

An elector must have lived at his/her current address at least 10 days prior to the election in order to vote in the resident's municipality.

Voters are required to provide their most recent address where they were previously registered to vote
