(c) Early start (footing/foundation only)	\$100.00
(6) Manufacturing and Industrial Buildings or additions thereto	\$6 per 1,000 cubic feet or fraction thereof, up to 50,000 cubic feet, \$2.00 per 1,000 cubic feet over 50,000, \$25 minimum
(a) Plan Review (new or addition)	\$75.00
(b) Plan Review (alteration)	\$40.00
(7) Electrical (where building volume can be calculated):	
(a) Residential	\$1.15 per 1,000 cubic feet or fraction thereof, \$25 minimum
(b) Non-Residential	\$2.00 per 1,000 cubic feet or fraction thereof, \$25 minimum
(8) Plumbing (where building volume can be calculated):	
(a) Residential	\$1.15 per 1,000 cubic feet or fraction thereof, \$25 minimum
(b) Non-Residential	\$2.00 per 1,000 cubic feet or fraction thereof, \$25 minimum
(9) HVAC (where building volume can be calculated):	
(a) Residential	\$1.15 per 1,000 cubic feet or fraction thereof, \$25 minimum
(b) Non-Residential	\$2.00 per 1,000 cubic feet or fraction thereof, \$25 minimum
(10) All other buildings, structures, alterations except fences; repairs (in excess of \$1,000 value); electrical, plumbing; HVAC; (where building volume cannot be calculated) [NOTE-permit is not for roofing or siding]; replacement windows,

tennis courts, fireplace, woodstove, furnace, AC or duct changes, pools, hot tub, water heater unless identical equipment, softener, turf sprinkler, backflow device, or plumbing fixture replacement, etc.

\$5 per 1,000 of valuation or fraction thereof, \$25 minimum. (NOTE: permit is not required for roofing, siding and water heater replacement if you are replacing identical equipment)
