



RECYCLING: It's a simple two-sort system!

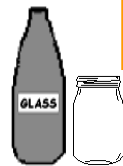
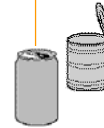


CONTAINERS

Rinse, mix together in reusable bin (no bag)

CANS: Aluminum & Steel
(food & empty aerosol)

Tuck loose steel can lids into can & squeeze to hold in.



JARS/BOTTLES: Glass
(clear, green, brown)

Put lids in trash.

PLASTICS: Check for a Neck!

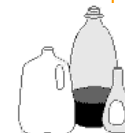
Put caps/lids in trash.

(clear, green, pale blue)



bottles & jugs ONLY!

PAPERS

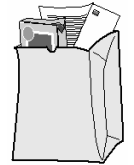
Mix together in paper bags

MIXED PAPER

INCLUDES:



- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Catalogues
- Phonebooks
- Paper egg cartons
- Office-type paper: white, color, shredded, etc.
- Junk mail
- Envelopes
- Container Board: (cereal & tissue boxes, soda cartons, etc.)
- Books: (hardcover, paperback)
- Paper rolls & tubes
- Grocery bags



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD



Flatten/bundle/tie 3ft by 3ft.
(May put **small** pieces/boxes in mixed paper bag.)

DO NOT INCLUDE:

Food	Plastic liners
Tissue products	Metal
Toweling paper	Milk cartons
Juice cartons	
Heavily soiled paper or cardboard	



Put **USED MOTOR OIL** in **clear** screw cap plastic jug (max. 2.5 gallon).
Do not mix with other liquids. Put vehicle **BATTERIES** in small box.
Call hauler for collection options, or self-haul to Portage County's Transfer Facility for **FREE** recycling service





Containers





CANS: aluminum, steel
(food & aerosol)

Aerosols*
Must be **empty**. Remove plastic lid unless part of can. Do not remove nozzle.

GLASS jars & bottles
(clear, green, brown)

PLASTIC #1 bottles & jugs

PLASTIC #2 bottles
(clear, green, pale blue)

- LEAVE labels on
- DO NOT crush
- RINSE all containers
- Put caps & lids in trash
- TUCK loose steel lids in can & squeeze to hold lids in
- LOOK on the bottom of plastics for a  
- MIX all containers together in bins or cans (Max. 33 gal.)
Stevens Point residents MUST use clear bags!

Lead-acid Batteries (vehicle)

- MAY be placed in small box

Used Motor Oil

- DO NOT mix with other liquids
- STORE in clear plastic container w/ screw cap, max 2.5 gallon size



DO NOT INCLUDE

- ~~Gasoline~~
- ~~Solvents~~
- ~~Oil-gas mixture~~
- ~~Water-contaminated oil~~

***Recycling is not mandated but strongly encouraged!**
Items listed must be separated from garbage to be recycled unless noted otherwise.

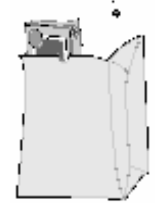
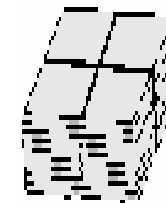
PHONEBOOKS

MAGAZINES/CATALOGUES

MIXED PAPER*

Includes:
Junk mail, egg cartons, office-type paper:
(white & color, envelopes, shredded, etc.)
Container Board: (cereal boxes, tissue boxes, soda cartons, etc.)
Books: (hard cover & paperback)
Paper rolls, tubes and grocery bags

- REMOVE plastic liners from boxes
- FLATTEN / BUNDLE / TIE corrugated boxes up to 3ft x 3ft
- MIX other papers in paper bags



DO NOT INCLUDE:

- ~~Food~~
- ~~Plastic~~
- ~~Tissue products~~
- ~~Metal~~
- ~~Toweling paper~~
- ~~Milk cartons~~
- ~~Juice cartons~~
- ~~Heavily soiled paper or cardboard~~
