ELECTIONS

§ 39-1. Duties of Village Clerk.

As provided in § 7.15, Wis. Stats., the Village Clerk shall have charge of and supervise all elections held in the Village.

§ 39-2. Election officials. (Amended by Ord. No. 19-10)

- A. Appointment. Election officials for each polling place shall be appointed pursuant to § 7.30, Wis. Stats.
- B. Number. Except as provided in Subsection C below, there shall be three inspectors, two election clerks and two ballot clerks for each polling place for each election.
- C. Reduction of number. Pursuant to § 7.32, Wis. Stats., the Clerk may reduce the number of election officials for any given election to not fewer than five and redistribute the duties of such remaining election officials.
- D. The Village Clerk shall have the discretion to schedule election officials to work less than a full day on the day of the Election.

§ 39-3. Nomination of elected Village officials.

All candidates for elective Village office shall file nomination papers pursuant to § 8.05(4)(b), Wis. Stats., and shall be nominated as provided in § 8.05(4)(a), Wis. Stats.

§ 39-4. Elector registration required.

The registration of all Village electors is required as provided in §§ 6.26 to 6.57, Wis. Stats.

§ 39-5. Polling hours.

The polls of the Village shall open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. for all elections.

§ 39-6. Polling place.

The polling place for the Village shall be the Plover Municipal Center.
